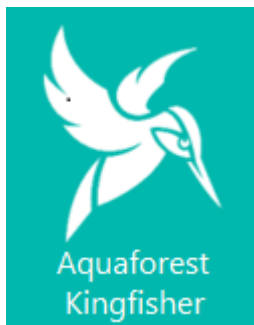

1 UPGRADING FROM EARLIER VERSION

1.1 Requirements

This release requires both version 3.5 and version 4.6 of the .NET framework. The setup will check whether they are installed on your system and if not, will take you to the appropriate Microsoft site to download and install.

1.2 Preserving Existing Job Definitions when Upgrading

Existing job definition and status files from earlier versions are not compatible with Version 2.0. Kingfisher will Upgrade these files when the GUI is opened for the first time.

The job definition files are in the “conditions” and “status” folders in the product installation folder. If the new release is installed in a different location (which by default was installed under C:\Aquaforest\kingfisher) these folders may be copied to the new location.

1.3 License Keys

This version has a different license key from previous versions.

2.1 New Server Version Features

2.1.1 Scheduler

Kingfisher 2.0 now can run jobs using a scheduler, this will allow you the use Watch folders. The diagram below shows the job scheduler.
